**ORDER VACATING ORDERS GRANTING MOTIONS
FOR RULE 2004 EXAMINATIONS**

On July 6, 2023, Master Lending Group, LLC, the Debtor in this case, filed a Chapter 7 petition. (Dckt. 1). On August 2, 2023, the Chapter 7 Trustee, Tiffany E. Caron, moved for permission to conduct examinations of Workmen’s Circle Credit Union, William Wilson Riddle, Jr., and Robin DeAnne Riddle Robertson under Rule 2004 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the “Bankruptcy Rules”). (Dckt. 58, 59, 60). The Court granted those motions on August 7, 2023. (Dckt. 74, 75, 76). On August 21, 2023, the Estate of Gregory M. Hirsch filed a limited objection to the Trustee’s proposed Rule 2004 examinations. (Dckt. 103). These matters came on for hearing on September 12, 2023, and were continued to November 8, 2023. (Dckt. 106, 143). Before the continued hearing, however, the Trustee filed withdrawals of her three motions on November 6, 2023. (Dckt. 175, 176, 177). The Court construes the Trustee’s withdrawals as motions to vacate under

Rule 60(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure (the “Federal Rules”), which is made applicable by Bankruptcy Rule 9024 and permits the Court to “relieve a party or its legal representative from a final judgment, order, or proceeding[.]” Fed. R. Civ. P. 60(b). The Court finds sufficient cause under Federal Rule 60(b) and therefore **VACATES** the orders (dckt. 74, 75, 76) granting motions for Bankruptcy Rule 2004 examinations of Workmen’s Circle Credit Union, William Wilson Riddle, Jr., and Robin DeAnne Riddle Robertson.
